Chuck Mawhinney holds the Marine Corps' record for the most confirmed sniper kills, having recorded 103 confirmed kills and 216 probable kills in 16 months during the Vietnam War. Chuck was born in 1949 in Lakeview, Oregon and died in 2024, in Baker City, Oregon.

The Marine Corps League Crater Lake Detachment #373 located in Klamath Falls, Oregon has been working on a way to recognize and remember Chuck for his accomplishments.
